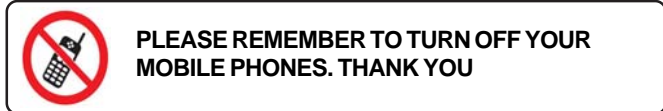
2. Continue to uphold our Pastoral Support Team as they serve us. They have been called to support the pastor in the leadership in service of the church.
