

earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.” – Ex. 20:8-11.

“What does **“The seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God”** mean? The Jews believed in keeping the Sabbath very strictly because breaking it carries a death sentence. (Ex 31:14) When Christ came to set us free, He taught that it was not the legal aspect of the Law that is important but more the heart of the Law. During the New Testament era, believers began to see a different meaning to the seventh day. After the Resurrection of Christ on the first day of the week, they began to dedicate the first day of the week to the worship of God, a day set aside from the other six days to be a “holy day”, a day sanctified unto the Lord. Six days are for us but the seventh belongs to God. It is to be “set aside” sanctified, kept holy or “wholly” to God. It is a “holy day” from whence comes the word “holiday.” We dedicate this day especially to serving and worshipping Him.
