So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son. (NLT)

Jesus always prays to the Father, how can He be God and be praying to God? Does not these questions and other like these baffle you often?

God is referred to as "**The Great I Am,**" He is the Omnipotent, Omnipresent and Omniscient God Who was, Who is, and Who always will be. The nature of the GODhead (three in one) is the greatest of all miracles.
