At such time we may even reject His offer to help. We may even think that His call *“Do not be afraid, it is I.”* is a figment of our imagination.

In this episode, the disciples accepted Him and were willing to take Him into the boat. Notice what happened when they took Jesus into their boat. **“... immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading.”**

No matter what our situation may be, however impossible our situation may seem, Let Jesus come into your boat and you will find yourself at your final destination.
