

Israelites who had not given up totally. So He had a plan of deliverance for them. He sent His servant Moses to do the job, but the task was colossal. When Moses told them what God had sent him to tell them, they responded incredulously. They did not even want to listen to him. They have despaired beyond hope. Sometimes when life becomes so discouraging and hopeless that we lose all hope, it can actually make us sick.

God had to free the Israelites from bondage so that they can return to the true worship of Himself. In the next four chapters of Exodus, chapters 7-10, **seven times** God asked Moses to deliver His command to Pharaoh with the words. "Let my people go, so that **they may worship me.**"

Bondage prevents us from worshipping God. Are you in bondage today? What keeps you from entering true worship? Drugs, alcohol, gambling or many vices of life can keep us in bondage, but secret sins can be the worst impediment to worship. Do you know that work or business too may keep us in bondage so that we fail to enter into freedom in Christ during our workday? Today, ask God to show you the areas of bondage that you are living in so that you may truly worship Him.
